River Colne Tiger Cubs Venue Rules

Opening Dates: 16th June – 14th March

- This fishery belongs to Boyers and URACS members have the right of access. Please have your Uxbridge Rovers membership with you at all times and abide by Boyers and Uxbridge Rovers rules.
- Boyers and Uxbridge Rovers reserve the right to withdraw permits or offers at its absolute discretion. In that event all fishing rights of the former permit holder shall immediately cease, and no refund of monies shall be made.
- 1 rod only
- Any member acting in an unsportsmanlike manner is liable to have their permit withdrawn.
- Any member found to be intoxicated or taking drugs will incur a permanent ban.
- No member may take up their swim prior to the season starting.
- All fish caught are to be returned to the water as soon as possible.
- Permit holders must carry their permit with them whilst on the company's property and be prepared to produce it on the request of any bailiff or member. Failure to produce a valid permit will result in them being asked to leave.
- Fires, barbeques, swimming, full size boats, shooting, gaffs and fireworks are not allowed.
- No braided mainline except on marker and spod rod and on lure/spinner fished pike rods.
- Peanuts are not to be used as bait on any venue, either as hook bait or loose feed.
- Anglers are responsible for removal of all litter in their swims, regardless of who left the litter. Repeated offenders will incur a permanent ban.
- Fishing tackle of any type must not be left unattended
- Bivvies/tents are not permitted on any venue.
- Night fishing is allowed. Shaded lights only.
- Lead core/tungsten leaders or hook length are not permitted – all shock leaders must be nylon.
- All anglers must be in possession of a suitable landing net & unhooking mat. (Noncompliance will result in the angler being asked to leave)

- Stainless steel hooks, bent hook rigs or Fox Series 5 hooks may not be used. No lead core line. No fixed lead rigs. All leads must pass freely over leader knots.
- Pike anglers must be in possession of forceps at least 8" in length.
- Pike anglers mainline must be a minimum of 12lb breaking strain.
- Pike anglers must use wire traces at all times.
- Pike anglers using more than one rod must use an audible bite alarm on the second rod to avoid the deep hooking of pike.
- The use of pike gags is prohibited on all venues.
- Please make sure the gates are shut and locked after use.
- Combination lock numbers must not be given to non-members. If this occurs your permit will be instantly withdrawn.
- No guest are permitted at this venue
