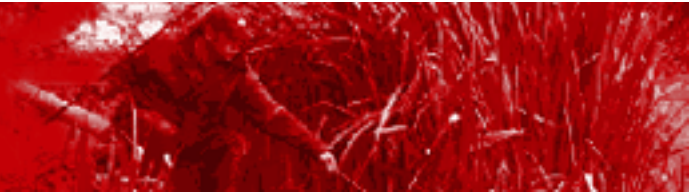

GOLF COURSE LAKES, DENHAM, BUCKINGHAMSHIRE



picked off on tench or carp tactics. Float fish maggot or caster, over loose feed, for silver fish.

GOOD SWIMS. The 'causeway' swims are popular on both lakes.

TICKETS. Members Only. Uxbridge Rovers ACS fees are £80, family (adult and partner plus two 13-18-year-olds) £118, students 18-21 £60, OAPs £53, registered disabled £43, 13-18-year-olds £28, under-13s are free if accompanied by an adult member. 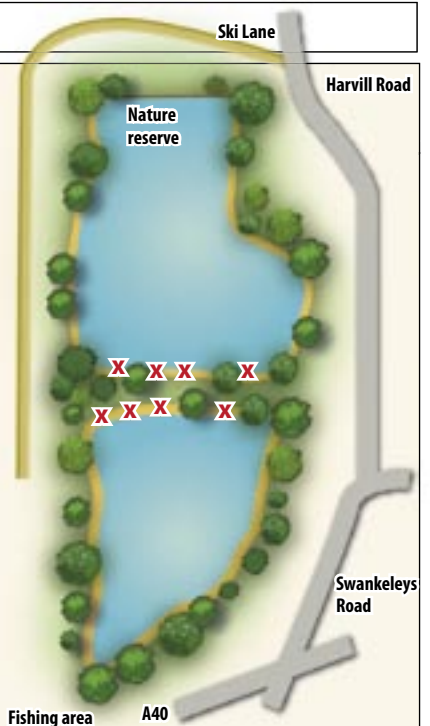
DESCRIPTION. Controlled by Uxbridge Rovers ACS these two six acre secluded and peaceful lakes are set on Uxbridge Golf Course. North Lake has tench to 6 lb, some carp to 25 lb, pike to 15 lb, some bream to 10 lb, perch to 2 lb plus roach and rudd to 1 lb. South Lake has tench to 9 lb, and similar stocks and sizes to the North Lake. Both have eels to at least 5 lb.

TACTICS. For carp, they're a good challenge, leger hair-rigged boilies or large halibut pellets over PVA'd particles. Most are taken by members night fishing. Tench to pole, waggler or feeder fished corn, soft pellet, caster, worms or maggot. Bream tend to be

LOCATION. From J1 M40 take the A40 Western Avenue heading east. Turn left into Swakeleys Road then bear left at the mini roundabout into Harvil Road. Turn left into Uxbridge Golf Course and park on the extreme left of the car park. Access the lakes via the public footpath (about 600 yards walk). Sat Nav reference UB10 8AQ (golf club).
