River Colne Denham Venue Rules

Opening Dates: 16th June – 14th March

- 1 rod only
- Fish from marked pegs only (Applicable to central gravels only)
- Barbless hooks only (Crushed barbs are not permitted)
- Treble hooks for predator fishing must be barbless or crushed
- Pike anglers must be in possession of forceps at least 8" in length.
- Pike anglers mainline must be a minimum of 12lb breaking strain.
- Pike anglers must use wire traces at all times
- No braided mainline unless fishing with a lure rod for predators, 12lb minimum
- The use of pike gags is banned on all venues.
- No live baiting
- No BBQs, stoves or fires
- No litter
- No radios
- No boats
- No night fishing. Fishing is restricted to one hour before sunrise until one hour after sunset
- All anglers must be in possession of a suitable landing net & unhooking mat. (Noncompliance will result in the angler being asked to leave)
- All barbel should be held in the flow until they are strong enough to swim away
- Fishing is not permitted on the meadows stretch from the concrete bridge at Denham Lock down to the A40 bridge
- Please make sure the gates are shut and locked after use.
- Combination lock numbers must not be given to non-members. If this occurs your permit will be instantly withdrawn
- fishing for barbel or chub with braided hook links min 12lb reel line.
